#### **PROCEDURE**

Students will attend school as normal, be transported to the pool by bus, complete their lesson and return to school for the remainder of the day.

**Please note** – Session 1 is scheduled to leave school at **8.50am** so please be at school prior to this.

**IMPORTANT** – Due to the difficulties of having the students change at the pool with limited time, public space and lost property being an issue - we will have the students dry off at the pool and then get changed back at school under the supervision of their teachers. Please ensure your child has a warm jacket/dressing gown to wear on the journey back to school.

#### **STUDENTS WILL NEED**

- To wear bathers to school, under school uniform.

##### **IN PLASTIC BAG TO TAKE TO POOL**

- Thongs / sandals to wear to the pool
- Towel
- Goggles (if required)
- Drink bottle
- Any medication your child requires – **teacher to be informed.**
- A warm jumper/dressing gown to wear after lesson.

##### **IN SCHOOL BAG AT SCHOOL**

- Change of underwear
- School Uniform / Shoes
- Plastic bag to wrap wet towel / bathers in once changed back into school uniform at school.
